



1. Roll call, Declaration of quorum being present. 9: 08 meeting begins – Anita – here, Melissa- here, Beverly- here
2. Public Participation – Mark Johnson – I don't know if you listened to what the CPA said, you can amend the budget but June 30 if you spent more than you brought in, you are personally liable for that. You only have 5 months and you don't know what will happen in that 5 months. If you don't begin to make adjustments now, you will be liable and that is an offense and we citizens can have you removed from the board. That's how serious this is.

We need to get an engineering report and a cost so we can apply for the grants. Approve the execution of the consent order- Anita makes motion to approve the consent order, Melissa seconds. Vote –Anita – yes; Melissa – yes; Beverly – yes. Mark requested more information on this consent order and what it entails. Toms replied basically the water we are receiving from Snyder has some problems and they are in the same situation as we are. There are some things we may be able to do to help. What are those things, Mark asked. Tom replied that he is not an engineer, we have several years to fix this.
6. Reports from Water Superintendent Clifton Vaughn- Hanes is coming to look at lift stations to try to figure out what's going on with them. Pete Barton asked when he was going to get started on a water line. Clifton replied that we were waiting on OKIE for markings, Pete informed him there were blue flags there. Clifton let him know that those are from us, we are still waiting on OKIE.
